INTRODUCTION

As we look around we notice that there are many Christians in the body that seem to be more spiritually successful than others. This was something that I noticed years ago. I wondered why I couldn't be as successful as some of the great men of God that were in the body of Christ. It wasn't until recently that God has began to reveal to me the difference between them and I. It wasn't anything miraculous. It

was more of receiving a revelation from God's Holy Word! The one thing that separates great men and women of God from those that are mediocre, is PRAYER! God expects more from His children than mediocrity. He expects us to be the very best that we can be by using all of the principles and laws that he has set into motion.

We need to operate under spiritual principles and spiritual laws. In

Luke 17:21, Jesus tells us that the kingdom of God is within us. It's not something we wait for. Every kingdom has laws, and the Kingdom of God has its own laws. Many people struggle to pray to God because they do not see Him, and the idea of praying to a God you can not see is a struggle. Before being born again we spent our life living in the natural and using our natural senses. We struggle to see our life from the inside out and feel more comfortable seeing from the outside in. God created man as a spirit being. Your spirit lives in a body and has a soul. We need to see through the eyes of our spirit. 1 Cor. 2:11-14 says, *"For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so, the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. 13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. 14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned."*

When you begin to pray, begin to see with your Spirit, you will know that you are in God's presence. The one that loves you with a love greater than you could ever imagine. In the Old Testament, it uses the Hebrew word "checed", pronounced kheh'-sed. It means an unlimited supply of goodness, mercy and loving kindness. It is used 136 times for the word mercy, alone. It's a word to describe how all of these attributes are unlimited. You can trust that the God that loves you beyond your understanding is in your midst when you pray.

Jesus Is Our Example

To understand the power of prayer and how it connects our spirit with God's Spirit, we merely have to look to Jesus as our example. The bible gives us plenty of references for the many times we see Jesus spending time in prayer. Here are just a few. Mat. 14:23; Mark 6:46; Mark 1:35; Luke 5:16; Luke 9:18; Mat. 26:36-44. His disciples saw the power of prayer in Jesus' life on a daily basis. In Luke 11:1 Jesus had just finished praying when one of them ask, "teach us to pray." They wanted this power and this anointing they were seeing as they were with Jesus. They wanted this kind of prayer life. Jesus teaches them how to pray by praying what we have been taught as, The Lord's Prayer. The Prayer Partner takes that prayer and breaks it down into detail and establishes a basis for how we should pray.

Jesus knew the purpose of what this power and anointing were for. He understood what He needed to give to his people, could only be found in God's presence. Look at John 14:10. "Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works." In verse 24, Jesus tells him the words that he spoke was not his own, but the Father who sent him. In John 12:49, He explains that His Father tells him what to speak and that is what He speaks. In John 5:19 Jesus tells them he does what He sees his Father do. Jesus spent time in prayer to hear from His Father in order to know what to say and what to do. You may say, "yes, but He was Jesus." If that is how you feel, I have great news. 1 John 4:17 says, "Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world." That's right, we are like Jesus... now...in this world, not when we are in heaven. John 17:23 says, "...and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me." That's right, even Jesus said that the Heavenly Father loves you as much as He loved Him. What an eye opener. Understand that He not only loves you as much as He loves Jesus, but also know that His love is boundless, it's unlimited. That's what the Old Testament word, checed is saying to us.

Let me share something else that I saw recently as I was listening to one of my favorite pastors. John 14:16-18 says, *And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; 17 Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. 18 I will not leave you <u>comfortless:</u> I will come to you." In verse 18 He says He will not leave us comfortless. The word comfortless comes from the Greek word "orphanos." It means, orphan, without parents, without guidance. He tells us he is not going to leave us as orphans but, is going to adopt us and be our Father. He will lead us and guide us as a parent. That's why Paul tells us in Romans 18:15, <i>"For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.*" Both of these words, Abba and Father mean, father. Jesus knew the word abba was a Chaldean word used at that time to represent the intimate loving relationship a child has with his father. His audience knew exactly what Jesus was saying.

We have been adopted by a Heavenly Father and we can have a very deep, personal and intimate relationship with Him. A committed and dedicated prayer life is how this will happen.

Over the years I have tried different methods in my prayer life. After I was first saved I prayed every day. But after a while, that newness wore off and I, like many others, found it hard to pray on a daily basis. I knew it was important not only to pray but to be powerful and bold in my prayers.

I had always thought that the purpose of prayer was to ask God for things that you wanted in your life. But, prayer is the channel that we are to use to fellowship with and minister to our Lord and our God. It is not a time to ask what God can do for us but what we can do for God! Read that last sentence again and really let it sink into your spirit. Our attitude in prayer will determine how successful our prayers will be. God is our Father and as such, wants us to be blessed with many things however, He will not allow us to be spoiled children who think we get anything we ask for if we cry and wine long enough, without thinking about the consequences. God forbid!

The Prayer Partner is designed to aid you in your prayer life. It will help you to learn the what, where, when and why of prayer. My desire is to see the Body of Christ full of prayer warriors, ready to do battle with the

Many people have spent their entire Christian walk praying haphazardly, not really having a dedicated or powerful prayer life. After using this prayer aid for just a few days you are going to begin to see your prayer life change before your very eyes. You will never again say that you find it hard to pray every day. You will look forward to your prayer time as your prayer life grows deeper and deeper.

Begin to allow the love of God to flow thru your life. Begin to visualize what Jesus has done for you. Realize the power that you possess thru Jesus and the responsibility that it carries. You can and will begin to have a successful prayer life. May God keep you and bless you.

How To Use This Prayer Partner

- 1. This is only a guideline to prayer, not the only way to pray. You will want to make changes. You may want to add things. You will develop your own style or approach to prayer.
- 2. Remember! This is your Prayer Partner. You can write in it or even add pages to it. Make whatever notes you would like.
- 3. Always take time to meditate on the Lord and give Him time to speak to you. These times can be the moments that God gives you great revelations.
- 4. You may want to change the order of things in which you pray.
- 5. Always look up the scriptures that are mentioned so that you can receive the full meaning of what you are confessing.
- 6. Look and study other scriptures that pertain to each area in your prayer life. This will give it a newness and keep you from becoming repetitious.
- Always take your time. You may want to divide it up into segments and pray more than one time a day. Please take your time.
- 8. Use the additional Scriptures on the back that I have arranged by topic.

Additional Tips

- 1. Set a definite time for prayer. Early morning hours are best.
- 2. Have a definite place for prayer.
- 3. Spend as much time on each area as you like or until you have a release.
- 4. Remove all distractions. Ask that no one disturb you.
- 5. Take the phone off the hook.
- 6. Keep your bible with you. Refer to it. Many times The Lord will speak to you through a scripture.
- 7. Have a pen and extra paper available for notes, for when something comes to your mind, or when The Lord speaks to you.
- 8. Pray whether you feel like it or not. God hears when we pray the Word in faith, not when we feel something.
- 9. Don't quit! You may not see the results tomorrow but they will come.

The Lord's Prayer

When asked to teach them how to pray, Jesus spoke what we know today as the Lord's prayer. Jesus spent much time in prayer. Some of His greatest miracles happened after He had spent much time in prayer. When the disciples asked one time why they could not cast out a demon, Jesus said that it took prayer and fasting.

The prayer that Jesus gave us has been given to help us set our life in order. By using this prayer as a guide and allowing the spirit and The Word to accompany it we can have total victory in every area of our life.

The ultimate authority of all things is God's word. Even though the Lord's prayer is a short prayer by most standards, it was not given so that we would repeat these few sentences once or twice a day. Each sentence in the Lord's prayer is to be used as a guide for that area of our life. We are to expound on all topics that it mentions.

The Role Faith Plays In Our Prayers

Before we begin breaking down the Lord's Prayer in order to help learn to pray, we first must understand the reason faith is so important. Everything we receive from God, we receive by faith. If someone were to ask you if you were really saved, what would you tell them? If they asked you how can you be so sure, what would you tell them? Most believers would say, it is just something I know, without a doubt. When each of us gave our life to Christ and became born again, we did it by faith.

Faith connects us to the power of God and make no mistake, it is a force. Our faith determines our actions.

Faith Is A Spiritual Force

Faith connects us to the power of God and make no mistake, it is a force. Our faith determines our actions. For example, if I were to ask you to come into my office and have a seat would you think twice about sitting down in one of the chairs in my office. Most would just sit right down without worrying if that chair would hold them up or doubt the legs were strong enough to hold them. No, you would just sit down, because you have faith in that chair. Your faith is so natural and automatic you just act upon that faith. God wants the same thing from us in our daily life and in our prayer time. You will notice I am suggesting we are to mostly be praying God's Word during our prayer time. Why? Because His Word is His Will for our life.

God has always been a God of seed time and harvest. In Genesis (Gen. 1:29) He says that He gave every herb bearing seed, every tree with fruit bearing seed for meat. Adam was to use those seeds to provide for himself to meet his daily needs. In Matthew 13 we learn about the sower of the seed. In Luke's version, The Lord tells the disciples that the seed is The Word of God. God has given us His Word to plant into our lives to provide us with

Then, How Do We Get Faith

Romans 10:17 says, "*So then, faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.*" Notice it did not say faith cometh by reading the Word, looking at the Word or thinking about The Word. It is important we HEAR The Word in our ears. When you read The Word, read it out loud so, your ears can hear it.

How Do We Sow God's Word In Faith

To answer that question, lets look at Luke 17:6, "*And The Lord said, If you had faith as a grain of mustard seed, you might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.*" Notice He did not say if you had faith the size of a mustard seed. This has been an incorrect teaching in the Body of Christ. He was trying to get them to understand the importance of planting the seed, not the importance of the size of the seed itself. He was trying to explain, if you had a seed, if you have my Word, you would plant it and it, The Word, would obey you. God's word is living and active (Heb. 4:12) and has all the life in it that is needed to bring forth fruit. His Word will not return void. (Is. 55:11) Psalms 119:11 says God's Word has been settled in Heaven forever. His Word is the final authority.

How Do We Plant God's Word

Hebrews 11:1 says, "*Faith is the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things not seen.*" The word "evidence" comes from a root Greek word, elegcho, which means, to convict, refute as in a testimony in court. If a person gives their testimony in court, they are attesting to something they saw or heard. Faith is the substance of

things hoped for, the testimony of things not seen in the natural. We are testifying to what His Word says because this is what we see. This is why we "*walk by faith and not by sight.*" (2 Cor. 5:7) We plant God's Word, His seed, by speaking forth His Word, verbally, and testifying to what we know the truth to be. "But what if my situation is the opposite of what God's Word says, won't I be lying." No, to speak anything contrary to His Word is lying. "*Sanctify them through Thy truth: Thy Word is truth.*" John 17:17. There is a difference between facts and truth. The facts may be that you are sick or have an incurable disease, but His truth says you are healed by the stripes of Jesus. His truth always triumphs over natural facts. Facts are nothing more than Satan's version of the truth he wants you to believe. This is why it is so important we watch what we speak. Proverbs 18:21 says, "*Death and life are in the power of the tongue.*" God says in Joel 3:10b, "*let the weak say I am strong.*" That is exactly what Jesus taught throughout the Gospels. Proverbs 15:23a says, "*A man hath joy, by the answer of his mouth.*"

Understand that there is creative ability or a creative force in God's Word. Just like a seed has the ability to create and that power is in the seed. If you plant an apple seed, you will eventually receive apples. When you

plant God's Word, by speaking it into your life, you will eventually receive a harvest of what His word says. In Genesis God said, let there be light and there was light. A preacher brought to my attention that in the original text it says, God said, light be, and light was. There is power in his Word. Hebrews 11:3 tells us the worlds were framed by God's words that He spoke. Keep in mind the opposite is also true. In the old testament, Moses had led the children of Israel out of 400 hundred years of bondage through great signs and wonders. Yet, the next day, they were saying, "you have brought us out to die in this desert." In fact, they continued to say this time and time again, "we're going to die in the desert." Guess what? All of them got exactly what they spoke out of their mouth. They all died in the desert without entering into the promised land.

The only exceptions being Joshua, Caleb, Moses, and Aaron. It was a completely new generation that went into and took the promised land.

I encourage you to spend time studying Mark 11:23-25. Also, spend time studying the healing and miracles Jesus did in the 4 Gospels. You will notice a reoccurring theme. In most cases, He says, "Thy faith has made thee whole." In other cases, He says, "Be it unto thee even as thou saith." Never dig up the seed or Word of God you have planed by speaking something opposite of what God's word tells us. In Mark 4:26-27 Jesus says that the kingdom of God is like a man who casts seed into the ground and goes to bed and gets up, goes to bed and get's up and the seed eventually springs up, even though he does not know how. Just keep speaking His Word into your life. I can promise you with confidence, **IT WILL** produce a harvest.

Our Father Which Art In Heaven

Psalm 100 says "*Enter His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with praise.*" You should spend time in thanksgiving and praise to God. Praying is you coming into the presence of God, but Praise is God coming into yours. The Word of God says, "*He inhabits the praises of his people.*" This time of worship and praise will help to clear our mind and spirit from things that tend to burden us down. This helps us to forget about our jobs, our families, and our problems and, really begin to concentrate on our Lord. Begin to think of at least one good thing that happened the day before that you can thank God for. I am sure that as you begin to think, you will remember more than just one.

Begin to thank Him for the oneness of God. Thank Him that the fullness of the Godhead rests bodily in Christ Jesus and that Christ came and died for you that you might have life and have it more abundantly. Thank Him that he sent His spirit to live and dwell in you and that He will never leave you or forsake you.

This is also an excellent time to thank your loving, Heavenly Father for all the good things in your life. James 1:17 says, *''Every good and perfect gift is from above.''* If it's good it's from God. You should thank Him for any and every good thing that is happening in your life. No where, will you ever find, where God's Word says He allows bad things or sends bad things in

order to teach us something. God **NEVER** sends or allows sickness into our life to teach us something, for an example. If God thought it important for Jesus to bare our sicknesses on the cross (Matt. 8:17), why would He want us to have the same sickness he died to destroy? Galations 3:13 says, "Christ (The Anointed One and His anointing) hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:" If you go back and study the curse of the law, you will find that all sickness is from the curse of not obeying the old Mosaic covenant. No man ever could, so was destined to be cursed. Jesus brought us the covenant of grace in order for us to be redeemed from this curse.

This time of worship and praise will create an atmosphere and environment that will not only prepare you for prayer, but will usher you into His presence with boldness and confidence. His Word declares we are to come before his throne of grace with boldness, courage, and confidence.

PRAYER

I come before You in the name of Jesus. I thank You that I am accepted in Him. I come before You with all boldness and confidence because of the sacrifice of Jesus. Eph. 1:6, Heb. 4:16.

Lord Jesus, I thank You for dying on the cross for me. You paid for my sins. You made it possible for me to come before the Father. You carried the punishment for my sin so I would not have to carry it. You rose from the dead so I could have a new life. You shed Your blood for me and removed all my sins. I worship You and call You my Lord. 1 Cor. 15:3-4, Gal. 3:13, 2 Cor. 5:17, Heb. 10.19, Rom. 5:9. I thank You for bringing me into the family of God. You purchased me and redeemed me to God. You made me to be an heir of the Kingdom of God. Heb. 2:11-13, Rom. 8:17, Col. 1:12, Rev. 5:10. I thank You that Your Spirit lives and dwells inside of me. Father, I thank You that you have all power, all knowledge and You are in all places at all times. I thank You that You are the only true and living God.

Hallowed Be Thy Name

God has revealed Himself to mankind by His name. The various names of God explain His nature and His power. God told Moses to tell people that the "I Am" has sent him. God told Moses "I am that I am". God is all things, to all people, at all times. In the New Testament Jesus uses the words "I am" many times. He said, "I am the deliverer", "I am the light of the world" and so on.

The people of Israel held God's name in awe and respect. His name was never mentioned lightly and many were afraid that they would pronounce His name incorrectly so, they would never actually pronounce His name.

Why Is God's Name So Important?

The obvious reason is that God's names describe who He is. They tell us of His character, His power, His Glory, His love, His thoughts, and overall, how He operates in this world and in our lives. But, there is another reason. It begins with the fact that God is a covenant God. God made several covenants with His people in the Old Testament, but Jesus came to bring us a new and everlasting covenant (Heb. 12:20). Praise God forever more! Hebrew 10:16 says, *"This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;"* Let me explain why God being a Covenant God is important to His names.

When people in the Old Testament made a blood covenant, which was common in that time period, it was the strongest form of commitment anyone could make with another. A blood covenant had 9 parts to it. Though I will not go into detail for each one, I will at least list them along with a couple of scriptures for each. I

encourage you to take the time to study this on your own to receive a deeper and more full understanding. The 9 Parts Of A Blood Covenant

1. **The two exchanged robes.** They represented the person themselves. He was offering himself; His entire life. 2 Cor. 5:21 *"For He has made Him to be sin for us who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him."* Is. 61:10 *"...for He hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, He hath covered me with the robe of righteousness..."*

2. **They removed their belt or girdle and offered it to the other person.** It held their weapons, knife, sword. He was offering His protection. They mess with you, they mess with me. Your enemies are my enemies. He has given us the armor of God. Eph. 6:14-18

3. **Cut the Covenant.** They would take an animal, cut them in half and lay them on the ground. They would then walk between them. This signified they were saying God do the same to me if I break this covenant. Read Gen. 15:; Heb. 9:22; Heb. 10:1-4 It is because He shed His blood on the cross we can **"come boldly to the throne of grace."**

4. **Raise the right arm and cut the palm of the right hand and clasp their two hands.** This signified they were now one with each. To intermingle their blood was to intermingle there life. Gal. 3:28. "There is neither Greek nor Jew; there is neither bond nor free, their neither male nor female: for ye are all one IN Christ Jesus." 2 Cor. 5:17 "if anyone be in Christ he is a new creation…"

5. **Make a scar or some identifying mark**, so others were aware of the covenant and that if they messed with you, the would also have to take on the one you were in covenant with. John 13:35 *"By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another."* Eph. 1:13 *...sealed (set a mark upon) with the Holy Spirit of promise."*

6: **Give terms of the covenant.** They would stand before a witness and list their assets and liabilities. They were saying everything I have is yours and everything you have is mine. Your debts are mine. I will take care of you and yours. 2 Pet. 1:4; Rom. 8:34; Heb. 8:6

7. **Eat the memorial meal.** They would take a loaf of bread and tear it in half, then feed their half to the other. They were saying, "this is my body, I am giving it to you. They took wine, "this is my blood that I am willing to spill for you."

8. **Plant a memorial tree.** This was to show the covenant to all generations. Everyone knows what the cross represents. Gal. 3:13 *"He has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us..."*

9. Exchange names. Each one took a part of the other one's name and incorporated it into his name. This again, helped to be identified with the other person. Jesus took on the name, Son of Man and we became Sons of God. 1 John 3:1, John 20:31; John 14:12-14; Acts: 3:16; Gal. 4:6 We were sinners, yet Jesus *"became sin for us that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him."* 2 Cor. 5:21 In the New Testament "name" means "authority, rank, command." In a blood covenant you invoke that person's name in times when you need authority.

All the things that the names of God are, belong to you and I. Think about that for a little bit. When you spend this time praising God for who He is through his names, realize, through the covenant, He has given us those names and calls us by those names. We have what those names say. Bless God forever more!

Where Did The Name "Jehovah Come From

In the Hebrew Scriptures, the name of God is recorded as YHWH. In the ancient Hebrew text, they did not use vowels, however, they did pronounce them in spoken Hebrew. They passed down the appropriate vowel sounds from generation to generation.

It was not until the 13th century that the term "Jehovah" appeared in written form. Christian scholars took the consonants of "Yahweh" and pronounced it with the vowels of "Adonai." This resulted in the sound "Yahowah." The Latin spelling is "Jehovah."

In the Lord Jesus, we receive the fullness of God. All that God is to man we receive in the Lordship of Jesus. As a Christian, we are not to take the name of The Lord vainly or "in vain". We should always give the Holy Spirit an opportunity to search our heart and show us if we are taking the Lord's name in vain. Are we failing to walk in righteousness that has been given to us in the Lord Jesus? If so, receive forgiveness and make a commitment to do so.

Take time to study the names of Jehovah and how they came about by reading the scriptures. You will have a greater understanding of His name as you read each one.

Rom. 8:2 I am sanctified by Your Spirit in the name of the Lord Jesus. I Cor.6:11 I am set apart for the master's use. 2 Tim. 2:21 I am a royal priest set apart to show forth Your praises oh God. I Pet.2:9 I am perfected forever by Your will oh God and You have sanctified me by Your Spirit. Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread

If we could ever get past worrying about our daily needs being met, we could go on to the perfection that Paul spoke about in Hebrews chapter six. How long will it take us children of God to learn that our heavenly Father will always be there to take care of us? David said in all of his life he had never seen the righteous forsaken or God's seed begging bread. Ps. 37:25.

You have a right as a child of God to pray that your needs be met. You also have the authority to pray for finances to be released unto you. Our needs go much farther than just our finances. We also should ask God to meet our spiritual needs as well. We need to ask for new revelations. We need to ask for spiritual gifts. lCor.14:1.

Even though God has made provision for our needs, sometimes satan tries to rob us of what God has already given us. We need to take authority over satan and take back what rightfully belongs to us. We must go in and possess the land.

Remember, in praying for financial needs to met, that God has set certain laws in motion. One of those is the law of giving and receiving. What a man soweth that shall he also reap. Gal. 6:7.

Prayer I thank You Father that: You take pleasure in my prosperity. Ps. 35:27 Whatever I do will prosper. Ps. 1:3 The wealth of the wicked is laid up for me. Forgive Our Debts As We Forgive Our Debtors

If a person wants to receive mercy, he must be merciful. Therefore we are not ready to receive God's forgiveness until we have forgiven others. On many occasions, it will be necessary to call people by name, forgive them and intercede for them.

People only do wrong things because they have problems in their own life. If we can help them by prayer and intercession they can and will change. Regardless of how you feel toward anyone, God commands you to forgive them.

Remember, forgiveness has nothing to do with feelings or emotions. When emotions try to make you think on past hurts, immediately begin to bless and pray for those who have hurt and offended you. To apply this is an act of choice not feelings. As you pray for and bless those who seem to be enemies, the peace of God will begin to flow into you and set you free from the hurt.

Each day you must submit your will to forgive. Don't wait until something happens to try to decide how to react. Decide how you will react in advance. Once you set your will in line with God's will, He will give you the grace to see you through.

You must also set your will to bless your enemies. This has to do with our words. We must determine that we will not speak evil of any person.

Galatians 5:16 says, *"Walk in the spirit and ye shall not fulfill the lusts of the flesh."* We should yield ourselves to the Spirit on a daily basis even on a moment by moment basis. Allow Him to bring forth His fruit in our life. Verbally, give the Spirit permission to work in you.

And Lead Us Not Into Temptation

Jesus taught that we must watch and pray to keep from falling into the temptations of the evil one. Just as we set our will to forgive, we must set our will to overcome the temptation of the devil. He is continually seeking whom he may devour. We must use our faith to resist the devil and see to it he never has the opportunity to devour us.

By the words of our mouth, we set our life on or off course. We must daily set our life on course and resist any attack of the devil against us, our family, our church and any other area.

Jesus taught us the only effective way to resist the devil when He was tempted of him in Matthew 4. Each time satan attacked, Jesus responded with scripture. The spoken Word of God is the only tool that we have to resist the devil.

When we speak God's Word in the name of Jesus, the devil has no choice but to flee from us. The word Flee means, to run in stark terror. The word "resist" means "to set over against." It is a military term that is used to set the battle in array.

You Have Been Given Authority Over EVERY Area Of Your Life

I would be remiss if I did not take some time to discuss what the Church has taught very little about. That is, the authority you have in Christ. Authority is delegated power and God has delegated his power to the church. Mark 16, 17-18 says, *"And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover."* Notice He said, "In My name." The Greek word for name means, "authority." He was saying, "I am giving you my authority." Acts chapter three, is the account of when Peter and John came upon the lame man at the Gate Beautiful. Peter tells him that he did

not have silver and gold. But, he grabbed him by the hand and said, "In The NAME of Jesus Christ, rise up and walk" and the man was healed. When they were later called into question over healing the man on the Sabbath, Peter tells them, "His name through faith in His name, has made this man strong." He was saying His authority by faith in His authority. If you go back to where I was speaking about the 9 parts of a blood covenant, one of those things was they took on the other person name. We took Jesus' name in this new covenant of grace. His name has authority.

"Jesus has already won the victory over Satan for us and there is nothing else he is going to do while we are on this earth." Jesus was not just speaking to his disciples when he told them in Luke 10:19, "*Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.*" He was speaking to all of us. Adam sold his dominion authority to Satan when he sinned in the garden and since then, according to God's Word, he is the God of this world. (2 Cor. 4:4)

Jesus has already won the victory over Satan for us and there is nothing else he is going to do while we are on this earth. According to Colossians 2:15 he defeated Satan and made a show of him openly. Let's look at Ephesians 1:19-22.

"And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power, 20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places, 21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come: 22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all."

Now, let's look at Ephesians 2:5-6

"Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:"

SPEAK OUT LOUD TO THE DEVIL. COMMAND HIM TO TAKE HIS HANDS OFF OF YOU AND YOUR LOVED ONES. SET A HEDGE AROUND YOU THAT THE DEVIL CANNOT CROSS OVER!

If you see satan attacking any area of your life, attack him with the Word of God and command him to flee from you. Find God's promises and confess them over that situation. Call God's promises yours. Do that until you have a peace in your heart that the situation is taken care of.

For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat. 11 For we hear that there are some who walk among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies. 12 Now those who are such we command and exhort through our Lord Jesus Christ that they work in quietness and eat their own bread. 1 **2 Thess 3:10-13** (NKJV)

We Were Created to do Good Works

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. **Eph 2:10** (NKJV)

There is a Reward for Doing Our Work Well

"And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. **Rev** 22:12 (NKJV)

Our Work is a Ministry through Our Gifts and Calling
