INTRODUCTION

A leadership dashboard is not a spreadsheet.

It is not a financial report.

It is not something you glance at once per quarter.

A leadership dashboard is a **focused system** that reveals the health, direction, and sustainability of your organization in real time.

It answers one central question:

If nothing changes, where are we headed?

Without a dashboard,
leaders *react* to outcomes.

With a dashboard,
leaders *anticipate* them.

- Diligence requires visibility.
- Visibility requires measurement.
- Measurement requires intentional design.

PART 1: FOUNDATIONAL QUESTIONS

Before selecting metrics, answer these three questions:

1

What Are We Actually Trying to Build?

- Growth?
- Profitability?
- Legacy?
- Kingdom influence?
- Sustainability?

Your dashboard reveals what you truly value.

What Could Destroy Us If Ignored?

- Cash flow strain
- Cultural erosion
- Customer churn
- Leadership burnout
- Margin compression

Your dashboard must protect against collapse — not just celebrate success.

3

What Drives Long-Term Sustainability?

- Recurring revenue
- Strong margin
- Loyal customers
- Engaged employees
- Spiritual integrity

If it drives sustainability, it belongs on your dashboard.

PART 2: THE FIVE CORE DASHBOARD CATEGORIES

A powerful leadership dashboard includes metrics in five areas:

1

Financial Health

Revenue, margin, cash flow & sustainability

2

Customer Health

Retention, NPS, referrals & churn

3

Operational Health

Conversion, delivery, capacity & quality

4

Team & Culture Health

Turnover, engagement, training & leadership

5

Spiritual & Leadership Health

Prayer, integrity, peace & alignment

1 FINANCIAL DASHBOARD

- Monthly Revenue (trend line)
- Gross Margin %
- Net Margin %
- Operating Cash Flow
- Cash Reserves (months of runway)
- Accounts Receivable Aging
- Customer Acquisition Cost (CAC)
- Customer Lifetime Value (LTV)
- Revenue per Customer
- Revenue per Employee

Revenue is vanity.

Margin is sanity.

Cash is reality.

2 CUSTOMER DASHBOARD

Revenue tells you what happened. Customer metrics tell you **what will happen**.

- Customer Retention Rate
- Churn Rate
- Repeat Purchase Rate
- Net Promoter Score (NPS)
- Referral Rate
- Average Client Lifespan
- Complaint Trends
- Response Time to Issues
- Contract Renewal Rate

Power Principle: Loyalty lowers volatility.

3 OPERATIONAL DASHBOARD

Operations determine scalability and margin.

- Lead Response Time
- Sales Conversion Rate
- Sales Pipeline Health
- Delivery Timeliness
- Error or Defect Rate
- Cost per Unit or Service
- Capacity Utilization
- Project Completion Time

Operational sloppiness eventually becomes financial weakness.

4 TEAM & CULTURE DASHBOARD

You cannot build a healthy company with a fractured team.

- Employee Turnover Rate
- Voluntary vs. Involuntary Exits
- Employee Engagement Scores
- Training Hours per Employee
- Internal Promotion Rate
- Conflict Resolution Speed
- Absenteeism Trends
- Leadership Bench Strength

"Two are better than one."

Culture is not soft. It is structural.

5 SPIRITUAL & LEADERSHIP DASHBOARD

This is where Christian leadership differentiates itself.

- Consistency of personal prayer / devotion
- Integrity pressure points
- Leadership burnout level
- Peace vs. anxiety levels
- Accountability relationships
- Decision-making clarity
- Alignment between mission and action

PART 3: LEADING VS. LAG INDICATORS

LAG INDICATORS	LEADING INDICATORS
<i>Tell you what happened</i>	<i>Tell you what is coming</i>
Revenue	Pipeline strength
Profit	Engagement levels
Growth rate	Response times
Retention	Training activity
Turnover	Customer satisfaction
	Marketing conversion rates

If you manage leading indicators well, lag indicators take care of themselves.

PART 4: BUILDING YOUR DASHBOARD

Step 1

Limit It

- Select 8–15 critical metrics.
- A dashboard is not a data warehouse. It is a clarity tool.

Step 2

Define Clear Targets

- Current Value
- Target Value
- Warning Threshold
- Clarity removes emotion.

Step 3

Establish Review Rhythm

- Daily → Operational metrics
- Weekly → Sales & pipeline
- Monthly → Financial & culture
- Quarterly → Strategic & spiritual alignment
- If you don't review it consistently, it isn't a dashboard.

Step 4

Assign Ownership

- Every metric must have an owner.
- Ownership creates accountability.

Step 5

Combine Data with Discernment

- Data informs. Discernment directs.
- What story are these numbers telling?
- What feels misaligned?
- Where is God prompting caution?
- Where is He opening doors?

DASHBOARD DEVELOPMENT CHECKLIST

FOUNDATION

- Defined success clearly
- Identified major risks
- Identified sustainability drivers

FINANCIAL

- Revenue trend tracked
- Margin monitored
- Cash flow reviewed
- Cash reserves calculated
- CAC measured
- LTV measured

CUSTOMER

- Retention tracked
- Churn monitored
- Referral rate measured
- Complaint trends reviewed
- Response time tracked

OPERATIONS

- Lead response time tracked
- Conversion rates measured
- Delivery timelines monitored
- Error rates tracked
- Capacity evaluated

TEAM & CULTURE

- Turnover monitored
- Engagement surveyed
- Training tracked
- Leadership pipeline reviewed
- Conflict resolution evaluated

SPIRITUAL & LEADERSHIP

- Reflection time scheduled
- Accountability structure in place
- Integrity risks identified
- Burnout evaluated
- Peace vs. anxiety examined

STRUCTURE

- 8–15 metrics selected
- Targets assigned
- Warning thresholds defined
- Review rhythm established
- Owners assigned

FINAL PRINCIPLES

What you consistently monitor, you intentionally improve.
